Racing / Scoring Philosophy

HMS System – Top competitors rise to the top

Division – Racing with equal skill levels

Trophies in both Gold and Silver divisions to keep up interest for majority of regatta participants.

Have a fun regatta.

1. Saturday HMS System:

- (a) Should get in 7 – 8 races which let top competitors rise to the top and have a minimum of one excluded race.
- (b) Saturdays HMS series points score (less excluded races) is carried over to Sunday's racing and may not be excluded from Sunday's series point score.

2. Sunday Gold and Silver Divisions

- (a) The top-level competitors are racing as a unit without lower level competitors interaction.
- (b) Competitors are not bouncing back and forth from A and B heats.
- (c) Top 5 in Gold and top 3 in Silver are awarded trophies which keeps up the challenge in both divisions.

3. If weather becomes an issue:

- (a) Rain/no wind on Saturday – will race HMS on Sunday. 5 trophies to top half, 3 trophies to bottom half.
- (b) Rain/no wind on Sunday – scores carried over from Saturday as final scores and awarded as above.
