SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by checking in with their club's junior office prior to the first start of each day.

3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be provided by the competitors' respective coaches.

4. SCHEDULE

Each club will hold their own skippers meeting at a time to be announced. The warning signal for the first race on will be 1345. Subsequent races each day will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race.

5. RACING AREA

The racing area will be for Sabots A-C2 in the Bessemer Basin adjacent to San Diego Yacht Club. The racing area for the Sabot C3 Fleet will be in the turning basin to the south of Southwestern Yacht Club

6. COURSES and MARKS

The courses will be announced audible from the RC Signal Boat prior to the warning signal. Marks may be hippity hops or pins with flags and will be recognized by their obvious positions.

7. STARTING AND FINISHING LINES; STARTING SYSTEM

The starting and finishing lines will be between a flag on the RC Signal Boat and a pin at the port end. The Sound Signal Starting System of Appendix Q of the racing rules will be used. For the Sabots A-C2 the start/finish line will be restricted.

8. PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to your coach within 10 minutes of docking. Protest hearings will be arranged by the two clubs as soon as possible.

9. SCORING

Only if at least 6 races are completed, each boat's worst score will be excluded from her series score. Ten races are scheduled. Three races constitutes a series. Competitors scored as DNC or DSQ will receive the number of entries in the series plus 1. Competitors scored as DNS, DNF or OCS will receive the number of starters that day plus 1.

10. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to competitors based on fleet size at the beginning of class the day after racing (July 10).
