## 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing except that Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are amended so that a boat that has broken a rule of Part 2 shall take a one-turn penalty.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all International Naples Sabot boats. The regatta will be sailed in four (4) divisions, Women's A, Women's B, Men's & Novice. Refer to the INSA class rules for definitions of each category.
- 2.2 Eligible Skippers must be at least 18 years old by November 8, 2008, and meet the eligibility requirements outlined by the INSA class rules.
- 2.3 Eligible Skippers will register on the day of the event by submitting an entry form and paying a \$25 entry fee. Non-skippers can participate in the Dinner Party for \$21.

## 4. MEASUREMENT

- 4.1 All boats must have a valid measurement certificate and carry a current INSA registration sticker.
- 4.2 All boats may be spot checked for safety equipment at any time during the regatta. Required equipment is whistle, paddle, bailer, wearable life vest and painter.

## 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration/Check-In at SDYC.

## 6. VENUE

Racing for all boats will be in San Diego's La Playa Cove.

## 7. SCORING

Three (3) races are scheduled of which one (1) race will be required to be completed to constitute a series.

## 8. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded for all divisions at the Regatta Dinner Party. Many year-end SCWSA trophies and recognition awards will also be presented.
