



NOTICE OF RACE
Thompson Cup
(Tune up for Lipton Cup)
Friday, May 16, 2008

1. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 1.1. This event is open to all J-105 class yachts in good standing with the class rules as amended by this NOR.
- 1.2. Yachts may register in advance by on-line entry at www.sdyc.org/raceinfo or by sending an email to sailing@sdyc.org containing the following information: boat name, sail number, skipper, and club.
- 1.3. Yachts may also register by phoning 619-758-6310 and leaving the required information as a message if no one answers.
- 1.4. There is no entry fee for this event.
- 1.5. To be eligible to race, boats must appear on the sign up list posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board. This list will be available from 1200 Thursday, May 15 to 0930 Friday, May 16. Boats not appearing on the list may not be scored.

2. RULES:

- 2.1. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005-2008;
- 2.2. The Deed of Gift and Conditions of Race for the San Diego Sir Thomas Lipton Challenge Cup adopted May 25, 1990 and the 1994 Protocol;
- 2.3. The J105 Class Association Rules, February 1, 2008, except as modified by reference in this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (hereafter "Class Rules");
- 2.4. This regatta is designated Category A in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20. Competing yachts may be required to display advertising chosen by the event organizer as provided in ISAF 20.3 (d)(i);
- 2.5. The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 while racing will be as provided in RRS 44.1 and 44.2, except that the penalty will be a One-Turn penalty, including one tack and one gybe. This modifies RRS 44.1 and 44.2.
- 2.6. There is no requirement that sails be numbered, or that sails carry the sail number of the boat on which they are used. This modifies RRS 77 and Class Rule 6.4.5. Boats without sail numbers must have bow numbers which will be issued for Lipton Cup.
- 2.7. The J105 Class Association Rules shall apply as listed for Lipton Cup in the NOR for that event.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Sailing instructions will be available at SDYC by 1700, Thursday, May 15, 2008.

4. LOCATION AND SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 The starting area and sailing venue will be in the Coronado Roads
- 4.2 Warning Signal for Race 1 on Friday, May 16 @ 1200 hrs.
- 4.3 Five races are scheduled.
- 4.4 Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible following the conclusion of the previous race.

5. SCORING

- 5.1 Scoring shall be by the Low Point Scoring System except there will be no excluded race scores. Results will be available from the Race Info section of the San Diego Yacht Club website (www.sdyc.org).
